1. The Joint Apprenticeship Committee will hold all information in strict confidence for the sole purpose of determining the applicant's suitability to learn the Plumbing, Steamfitting and Sprinklerfitting Trades.
2. If you require extra space to answer questions please use a plain sheet of paper and attach to the application.
3. Put your name on the top of all three copies of "Applicant's Personal Reference" form. These forms can be complete by people you know, past employers, but not those related by blood or marriage.
4. Attach high school transcripts, graduation certificate, GED marks, trade school marks or previous piping trades apprenticeship transcripts.
5. Enclose two photographs (2" x 2", can be done at the photo booths in the malls).
