CAR-BER Basic Orientation	Provides Employee with basic background information of CARBER. Informs employee of company policies, procedures, rules and discipline, and other topics from the LCM.
Isolation Training	Introduces the technician to the procedures for a CARBER Isolation Tool. There is also a hands on portion to this course
Weld Test Training	Introduces the technician to the procedures for a CARBER Weld Test Tool. There is also a hands on portion to this course
Cold Cutting	Introduces the technician to the operation of a wide range of brands of portable pipe lathe equipment. There is also a hands on portion to this course
